







- Internet Exchange Nepal, commonly knows as **nplX**, was **established in** 2002 as Nepal's first Internet Exchange point.

- npIX facilitates keeping **local traffic local**, making surfing much **faster** with local content for local customers, at the same time **saving international bandwidth.**


Internet Exchange basic diagram





2004 (1Mbps)


MRTG Graph of one of the peering ISP depicting growth in usage of npIX traffic


32G TRAFFIC AT NPIX AND WORLDCUP 2018 EXPERIENCE
